St. Vincent de Paul Georgia (SVdP Georgia) created the *Morning of Hope* event in 2020 to provide an opportunity for companies, organizations, agencies and individuals to **learn about the importance and impact of hope in lifting individuals and families out of poverty and to support low-income Georgians on their paths to stability and self-sufficiency.**

Postponed in 2020 and 2021 due to COVID-19, *Morning of Hope* in 2023 will be the event's second iteration. The 2023 *Morning of Hope* event continues a community tradition and serves as SVdP Georgia's signature annual event after 15 successful years of the Evening for Hope gala.

For 120 years, St. Vincent de Paul has provided assistance to tens of thousands of neighbors in need across Georgia annually. Since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic in early 2020, **SVdP Georgia provided over \$25 million in direct financial aid for rent, mortgage, utilities and medical bills to more than 48,500 households and \$10 million of in-kind assistance such as food and other necessities, impacting 225,000+ neighbors in need.**

During this time, SVdP Georgia also opened a new Community Support Center in Atlanta to better serve our neighbors in need. The new space features an only-one-of-its kind Community Pharmacy, enhanced and expanded Client-Choice Food Pantry, Teaching Kitchen, Jobs Center and Connected Classrooms.

Through these critically-needed programs and services and thanks to amazing supporters like you, SVdP Georgia is well-positioned to continue providing help and hope to individuals and families in need across the state for years to come!
