Advise your caseworker if something will impact your ability to pay rent on time.

Advise your caseworker if you will be away from the unit for an extended time period (Examples: 30, 60, 90 days).

Inform the landlord of maintenance issues.

Agree to follow up / respond quickly to inquiries and concerns.

Agree to maintain a relationship with your SVdP Georgia caseworker for a year and meet with them for their supportive services
