Gateway Center is also registered in Partners for Home- a coordinated entry point that has access to view available beds in Fulton County. Even though the Gateway Center provides emergency housing for males, they are a coordinated point of entry where females can receive referrals to emergency housing programs for women as well as receive some of the day services at the Gateway Center. Monday - Friday from 8-5pm phone screenings. They do a drug screen and require the veteran to go to a local police department to purchase a background check. Usually, it's \$5 for the background check. The process usually takes a couple of days but no more than a week. Parents with teenage sons may be allowed to stay.
