Thanks to generous supporters, we knew hundreds of families in our Motel-to-Home program would get keys to a new, stable home. We knew our pharmacy staff could provide free maintenance meds to uninsured patients that community partners like Clarkston Health Clinic would refer. And, we knew the pantries of our disabled veterans wouldn't remain empty, because the shelves at our Chamblee Support Center pantry would be adequately filled.

When I became Executive Director on January 1, 2023, the future imagined was already the present. Whether our Support Center staff or a fellow Vincentian volunteer

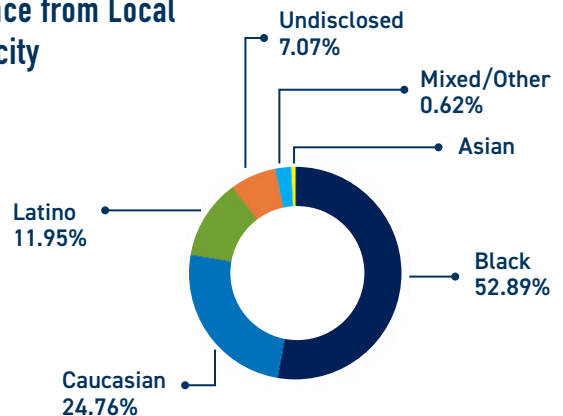
