WHAT CAN YOU BUY WITH SNAP?

- Fruits and vegetables
- Meat, poultry, and fish
- Dairy products
- · Breads and cereals

- Other foods such as snack foods and nonalcoholic beverages
- Seeds and plants that produce food for the household to eat

WHAT'S OFF LIMITS?

- Beer, wine, liquor, cigarettes, or tobacco
- · Vitamins, medicines, and supplements
- Foods that are hot at the point of sale
- Any nonfood items including, but not limited to, pet foods, cleaning supplies, paper products, household supplies, hygiene items, and cosmetics

The Georgia EBT card offers discounts, reduced/free admissions and other perks for you and your family, including:
