


ST. VINCENT DE PAUL PARISH-BASED CHAPTERS (CONFERENCES)

Parish-based chapters, referred to as Conferences, are based out of dozens of parishes throughout the state, with each Conference serving an assigned territory within its local community. Neighbors who call our assistance line are directed to the appropriate Conference for intake. Conferences establish their own guidelines for assistance, allowing leeway to find creative solutions that fit the needs of their communities. From community gardens and Christmas toy drives to rent and utility assistance — Conferences are the lifeblood of St. Vincent de Paul services within our communities.
