# Our Neighbors Are Facing a Crisis

Every Day, Families Are Forced To Choose Between Food, Housing, Or Medicine.

- In Georgia, **13.1% of individuals** face food insecurity, with **18.4% of children** affected.
- More than **one million households** are extremely burdened by housing costs
- **77% of those earning less than \$50,000** annually struggle to afford necessary medications
- Georgia ranks **2nd in the U.S.** for uninsured residents.

# When Our Neighbors Call, We Answer

## A Trusted Safety Net For Georgia Families In Crisis.

- In 2024, **281,000 Georgians** reached out to us for help.
- We delivered **\$29 million** in direct support.
- **94¢ of every dollar** went straight to programs and services that make a real difference.

More than charity, we are neighbors helping neighbors—a community of faith, compassion, and action.

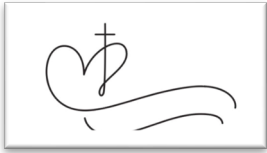

Our ministry is rooted in personal, one-on-one care.

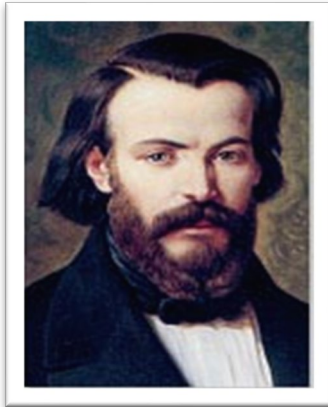
- We serve neighbors, not clients.

# Rooted in Faith. Inspired by Love.

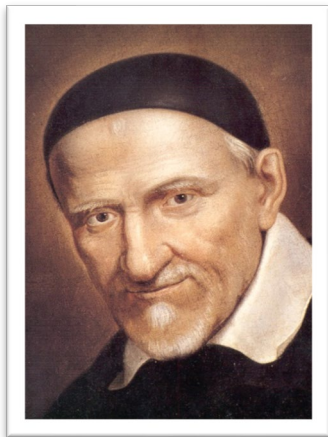
**The Society of St. Vincent de Paul** is the **largest Catholic organization globally** and operates in over **150 countries**.

In 1833, At just 20 years old, Frédéric Ozanam and his friends started The Society of St. Vincent de Paul in Paris to put their faith into action. With Sister Rosalie Rendu's guidance, they visited the poor face-to-face—just like we do today.



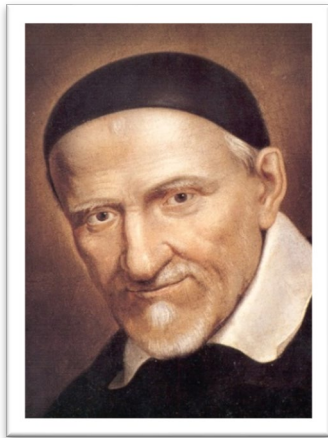
## Our Patron: St. Vincent de Paul

## Our Headquarters and Strategic Hub



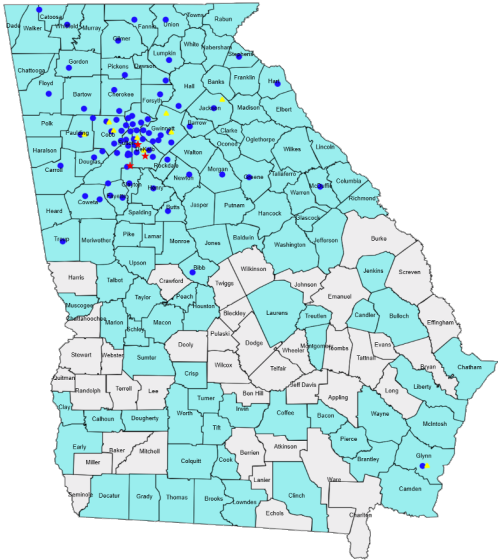
- Supports 74 Conferences (Parish Chapters) across Georgia

# Conferences in Georgia

In the **Archdiocese of Atlanta**, St. Vincent de Paul has a strong presence, with **Conferences in 72 of 93 traditional parishes**.

In the **Diocese of Savannah**, we have **2 Conferences serving 5 of 50 traditional parishes (8% coverage)**.

**77% of parishes in the Archdiocese of Atlanta have active Vincentians—triple the national average!** Our neighbors are supported by one of the most engaged volunteer networks in the country.
