

## SVdP GA Housing and Funding Programs to Support Neighbors in Need




Vincentians may request Council funding for these programs below. Neighbors should not apply directly to the Council, but instead are referred by a Vincentian who contacts Council.

Family Stability Grant	<p>SVdP Georgia’s Family Stability Grant offers a 50% match up of Conference direct aid to homeless families including shelter, housing and wrap-around support. Matched funding is capped at \$500 per family.</p> <p>Only Conferences may request funding. Georgia Rehousing Initiative	<p>The Georgia Rehousing Initiative (GRI) is a \$150,000 set-aside for Conferences to support rapid rehousing for homeless families. Financial assistance supports move-in costs, deposit and/or a portion of the first month’s rent.</p> <p>Transfer the case to Georgia Council. Neighbors do not apply for funds.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Household includes at least one child under age 18.</li> <li>– Rent is 40% or less of total income</li> <li>– Family must have an approved housing application with a welcome letter from the landlord</li> </ul>	<b>Statewide</b>

<p>House of Dreams</p> 	<p>3-bedroom apartment homes sponsored by St. Thomas the Apostle Catholic Church. Program includes mandatory life- and work-skill classes to help residents obtain and maintain employment, and save. <p>Marillac Moms</p> 	<p>Private, 12-15 month apartment lease for a homeless, single pregnant mother with children currently in her care. Includes life- and work-skills, job assistance, and maternity-leave respite and mentoring with a goal of building self-sufficiency and a stable home environment.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Confirmation of pregnancy; first or second trimester</li> <li>– Children currently in her care</li> <li>– Homeless</li> <li>--Agreement to comply with home and program rules and program stipend</li> </ul>	<p><b>Statewide</b> (current homes in Cobb, Gwinnett and Fulton counties)</p>
<p>St. Michael's House</p> 	<p>Group home at St. Michael the Archangel Catholic Church for single mothers. <p>Motel 2 Home</p> 	<p>Provides move-in deposits, up to \$2000, once housing has been found. Includes quarterly workshops for financial education, life-skills coaching, and job counseling among other topics.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Parent or Couple with dependent children under age 18. Limited availability as for households without children.</li> <li>– 30 days of motel receipts</li> <li>– 4 weeks of verifiable income</li> <li>– Landlord’s acceptance letter</li> <li>– Rent is less than 35% of monthly income</li> </ul>	<p><b>Statewide</b></p>
<p>STABLE</p>	<p>STABLE provides up to 90 days of motel stays followed by rent support for permanent housing.
